

Find funding programs and learn how to write grant proposals:

1. Search or browse the Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) by keyword or other indexes for federal grants, loans, business and non-financial assistance.
2. Search other Web sites that access Federal program and grants information for special Grant seekers, for example the [SBA.gov](#) , [the State and Local \[government\] Gateway](#) , or the [Non-Profit \[organizations\] Gateway](#) .
3. Search also for Private Foundations that might be interested in a project. Use the [Foundation Center Web site](#) in libraries to identify national, state, and community foundations.
