

Community Economic Development (CED) Projects

On April 27, 2012 the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Administration for Children & Families announced the availability of funding for the Community Economic Development (CED) Projects (*Catalog for Federal Domestic Assistance number: 93.570*). CED funding may be used to provide technical and financial assistance in order to create sustainable new employment and business opportunities for recipients of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) and other low-income individuals whose income level does not exceed 125 percent of the Federal poverty level.

The application deadline is June 5, 2012.

Eligible applicants include private nonprofit community development corporations.
