

Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance Programs

In the May 23, 2012 *Federal Register* the U.S. Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration announced the availability of funding for the Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance Programs *(Catalog for Federal Domestic Assistance number: 11.307)*

. The purpose of this program is to fund construction, non-construction and revolving loan fund investments under the Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance programs. Grants made under these programs will leverage regional assets to support the implementation of regional economic development strategies designed to create jobs, leverage private capital, encourage economic development, and strengthen America's ability to compete in the global marketplace.

The application deadline is September 14, 2012

. Eligible applicants include state and local governments, institutions of higher education and public or private nonprofit organizations.
