

The National Science Foundation announced the availability of funding for the Hydrologic Sciences program (*Catalog for Federal Domestic Assistance number: 47.050*). The purpose of this program is to focus on the fluxes of water in the environment that constitute the water cycle as well as the mass and energy transport function of the water cycle in the environment. This program supports studying processes from rainfall to runoff to infiltration and stream flow; evaporation and transpiration; as well as the flow of water in soils and aquifers and the transport of suspended, dissolved and colloidal components.
